Information for Financial Aid Recipients Who Withdraw Financial Aid Refund Calculation

Upon your withdrawal, NSU Student Financial Services will be performing a calculation (required by federal regulation) to determine if you will be required to repay any of the financial aid you received for the term. If your withdrawal date is before the 60% point of the semester, it is very likely that you will be required to repay a portion of the financial aid disbursed to you. If your withdrawal date is after the 60% point of the semester, no repayment will be required. We encourage you to visit with a financial aid counselor before withdrawing to determine if your withdrawing will result in any financial aid repayment.

Failure to Meet Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Requirements

Under NSU's Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy, financial aid recipients must meet two requirements to remain eligible for Financial aid. **They are:** 1. An hourly completion requirement based on your award status, i.e. full time, three-quarter time, or half-time. 2. A GPA requirement. By completely withdrawing from your classes, you will seriously jeopardize your ability to meet the first requirement above to maintain your financial aid eligibility. Student Loan Borrowers

If you borrowed through the Subsidized Stafford Loan, the Unsubsidized Stafford Loan, or the PLUS Loan program while enrolled at NSU, the date of your withdrawal will be reported to your student loan lender. Six months after your withdrawal date, you will be required to begin making payments on your student loans. If you return to NSU, please stop by Student Financial Services to pick up a Student Loan Deferment Form so your student loan payments can be deferred.
