

Student Organization Policies and Procedures

The Office of Student Affairs provides opportunities for student involvement and participation through student organizations, student activities and campus programming. These opportunities insure students are encouraged to become involved in all aspects of campus life.

Organizations recognized by the University will be afforded the following privileges: use of campus facilities for no or minimal charge, the opportunity to set up an on-campus account, if available, access to a mailbox specifically for that organization, to participate in the Student Government Association, access and permission to have a web page linked to the official university web site, to have the opportunity to participate in university activities and the ability to use "Northeastern State University" as part of the organization name (organizations not recognized may not use "Northeastern State University or NSU" as part of the organization name). University recognition in no way implies that Northeastern State University condones or supports any or all activities of a recognized student organization.

In order for an organization to be recognized on campus the following procedures must be followed:
